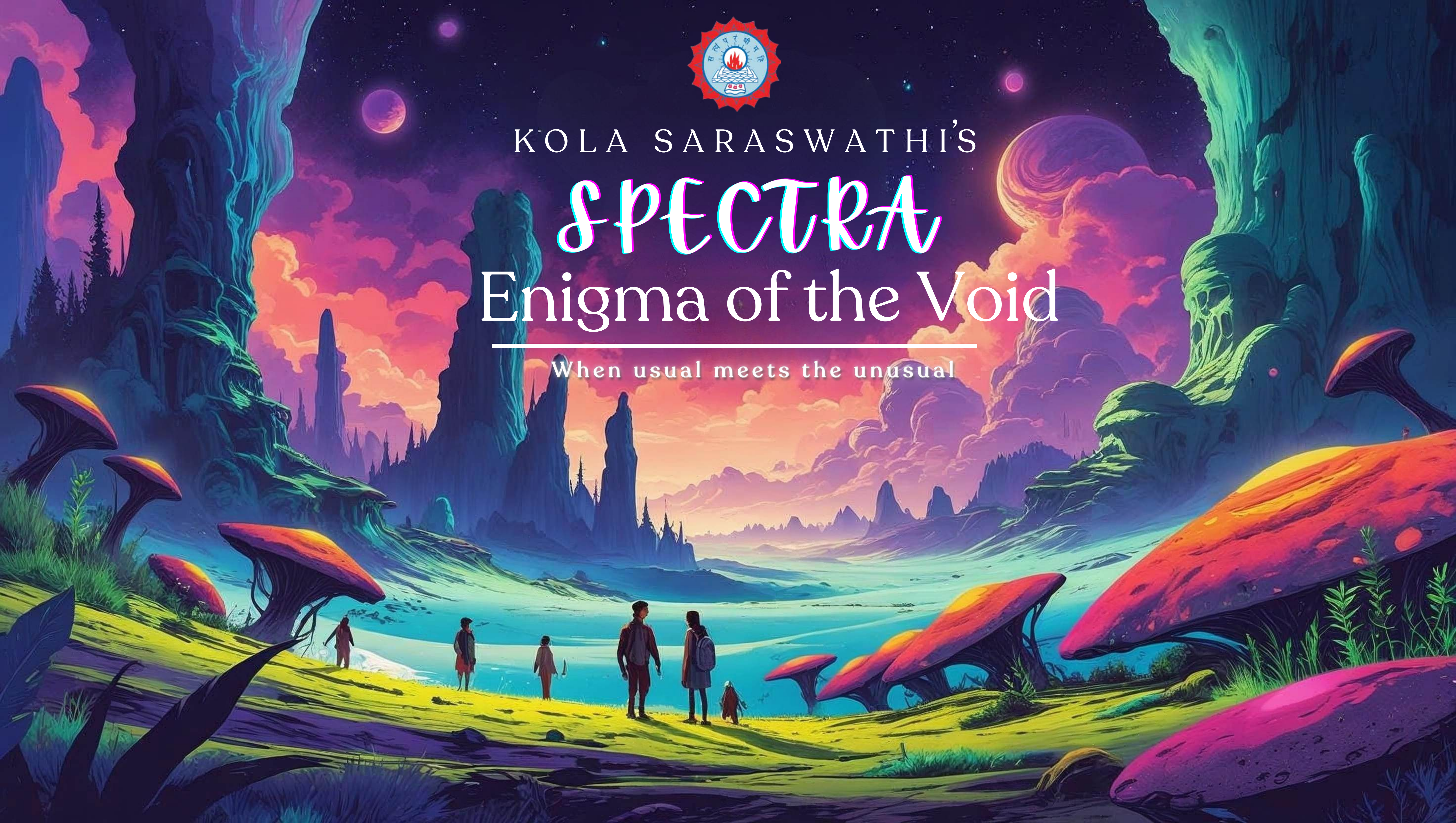

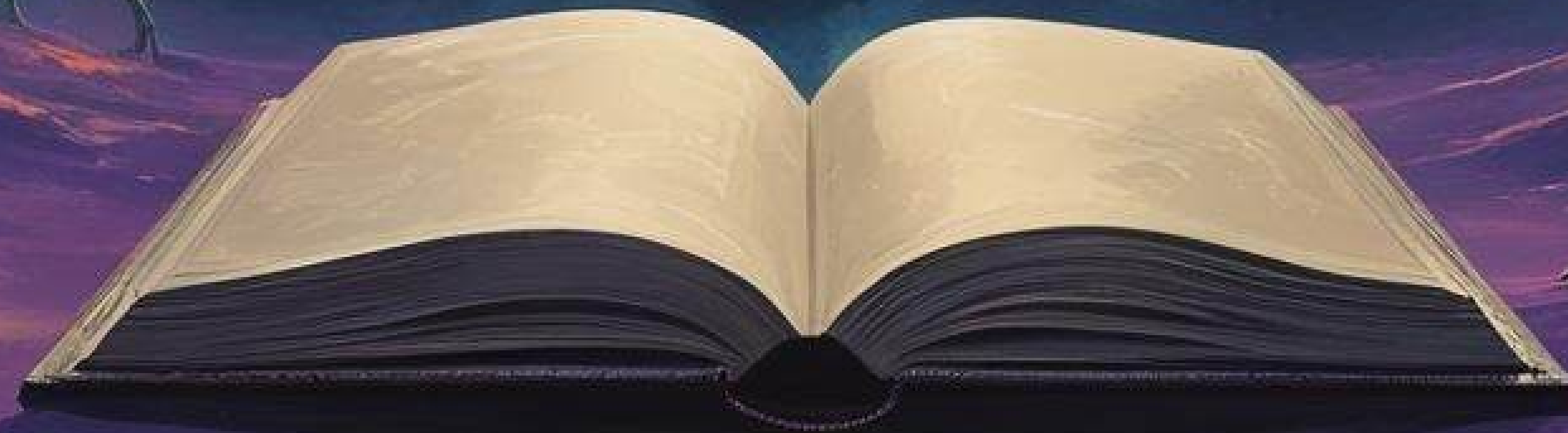

We are not just hosts, we are the voyagers of the unseen.

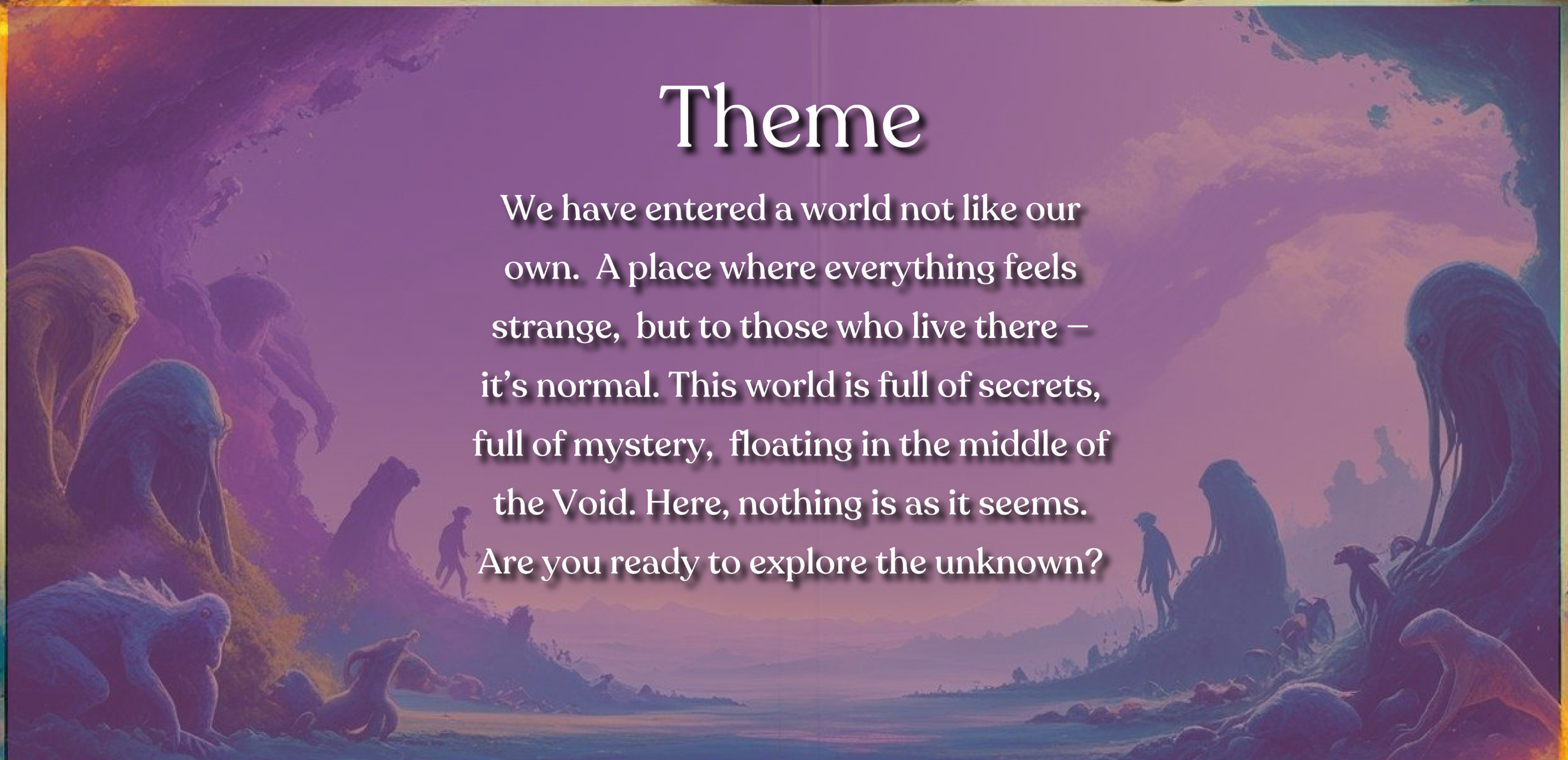





Flip The Script

Block and Tackle

- This is an Individual event.
- No. of participants per school: 2
- Participants will be assigned a topic and must present arguments either for or against it.
- The topic will be given on the spot.
- The medium of communication for the event is English, and the use of well-known slang words is allowed.
- Vulgarity in any form will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Minimum time limit - 2 minutes.
- In the event of a tie, a Red Round tie-breaker will be conducted, consisting of a 1 vs 1 debate with a mix of Block and tackle techniques.



Voice In The Void

Mono Acting

- No. of participants per school: 1
- Theme: **The Last Thought Before Erasure.**
- Meaning - You are a digital consciousness about to be deleted forever. This is your final plea, memory, or rebellion before becoming nothing.
- Timelimit: 2 to 3 minutes.
- Each participant performs solo, portraying one or multiple characters. The act can be an original piece or a well-known monologue.
- The use of minimal props and costumes is often encouraged.
- Offensive language, inappropriate themes, or explicit content are prohibited.



Case Closed

Lawyers Up

- Individual Event
- No. of participants per school: 2
- Preparation time: 5 minutes
- Participants will be given 2 minutes for the presentation, followed by a round of cross-questioning by the other participants and judges.
- Participants will be given an additional 90 seconds to present their closing arguments or summarization.
- Vulgarity of any kind will lead to immediate disqualification.




Sinking Showdown

Shipwreck

No. of participants per school: 2

- This is an individual event.
- Participants will be assigned a famous personality, which could be an actor, sportsperson, politician, or fictional character.
- Judging criteria include: Understanding of the character, humour, creativity and convincing skills.
- Abusive or offensive remarks will result in immediate disqualification.



Sense of Nonsense

Irrelevant Answers

- No. of participants per school: 2
- This is an individual event.
- The answers are to be given quickly.
- Participants should not repeat the same answer.
- Participants should not stutter while giving the answers.



Bluff Bluff & Professional Stubb

Professional Ethics

- No. of Participants per school : 1
- This is an individual event.
- Each participant receives a random profession on the spot.
- Speak on ethical responsibilities of the profession in a mystery-themed parallel universe.
- No specific case provided.
- Speak for 3 minutes.
- 2-minute preparation time before speaking.
- Performance must be original, ethical, and appropriate.
- Only English language is allowed.
- Offensive, disrespectful, or sensitive content leads to disqualification.



Spectra's got Latent

Stand Up Comedy

- No. of participants per school: 1
- Participants must not point out any individual or religion, and the use of foul language is strictly prohibited.
- Judgement will be based on content, fluency, spontaneity, presentation, and sense of humour.
- Only English language is allowed. No regional language is allowed
- There will be negative marking for exceeding the time limit.
- Duration: 4–5 minutes.



Sixty Mystery Seconds

Just A Minute

- No. of participants per school: 2
- This event is based on speaking skills, where 16 specific “don’ts” (obligations) must be strictly avoided while talking.
- The topic will be given on the spot.
- A set of 5 participants will be selected at a time.
- One of them will begin speaking, and the others may interrupt if any of the 16 obligations are used.
- Only English is allowed; use of any other language is strictly prohibited.
- Negative marking will be applied in case of deviation.
- Judgement will be based on vocabulary, fluency, and alertness.

The Great Indian Sale

Adzap

- No. of teams per school: 1
- Team size: 4-5 participants.
- A product will be given on the spot.
- Preparation time: 3 minutes.
- Judgment criteria: Humour, fluency, creativity and selling aspect of the product.
- Vulgarity of any form will lead to disqualification.



Let him cook

Flameless Cooking

- No. of teams per school: 1 (Participants - 2)
- Participants should not bring any prepared items.
- All food must be purely vegetarian.
- Ingredients and equipment must be brought by the participants.
- Heating appliances are not allowed.
- Number of items: 5, including one beverage.
- Participants will be judged based on presentation, nutritional value, creativity, and taste.
- Time limit: 90 minutes.

Cash me if you Can

Shark Tank

- No. of teams : 1
- Team size: 3-4 participants per team.
- Total time: 4 minutes.
- Pitch duration: 2 minutes + Q&A session.
- Participants must pitch an idea for a product or service and persuade the Judges (Sharks) to invest in their business.
- The pitch should be supported with a PPT or video.

Shark Tank

- Submit PPT/video via email to: spectra@kolasaraswathi.com
- Deadline: On or before 15th July.
- Participants must carry a pen drive with the PPT/video as a backup.
- Note: Any form of vulgarity will result in immediate disqualification.

Brush and Blush

Face Painting

- No. of teams per school : 1 (Participants - 2)
- Role allocation: One painter and one model.
- Theme will be mentioned 2 days before the event.
- Painters and models must report to their designated room at check-in time with all required materials.
- The following are strictly prohibited: stencils or stamps of any kind, masks over any part of the face, false eyelashes, special effects, contact lenses, novelty eyeglasses or sunglasses, use of reference drawings or photos while painting.

Rhythm Hijack

Adapt Tune

- No. of participants per school: 1
- The judge will keep switching the song to which the participants have to flaunt their moves.
- Music of any language will be played.
- Judging will be based on grace, expression, versatility and rhythm.
- Vulgarity in form of dress code or moves will lead to immediate disqualification.

Channel Chameleon

Channel Surfing

- No. of teams per school: 1
- Participants per team: 4–5
- The judge will keep switching channels.
- Participants can act or dance to re-enact the person or scene.
- They are permitted to use the original dialogues.
- Participants will be judged as a team based on their acting, humour, and dialogue delivery.
- No vulgarity of any form is permitted.

Moves in The Void

Dance

- No. of teams per school: 1
- Participants per team: 6 – 8
- Theme: **The Confrontation**

Meaning: The dancer meets the “Enigma” (a mirrored version of themselves, or a symbolic figure) and begins a duet with their shadow or reflection.

- Participants will be allowed to perform in any style related to the theme.
- Time limit: 3–4 min.
- Audio and backdrop must be submitted through mail ID - spectra@kolasaraswathi.com on or before the 15th of July
- Copy of the songs must be brought in a pendrive.
- No vulgarity in songs and costumes.

Void Vibrations

School Band Display

- No. of teams per school: 1
- Participants per team: 6 - 8
- Time limit: 4-5 minutes.
- Formation: Bands must maintain discipline, symmetry, and coordination throughout the display.
- Music Style: The band may perform school anthems, patriotic tunes, or any approved musical pieces.
- Uniform: All members must wear a proper and uniform band outfit.
- Instruments: Only non-electric instruments (e.g. drums, trumpets, bugles, flutes) are allowed.
- Conduct: No stunts, shouting, or disrespectful gestures.

Vouge Voyage

Fashion Show

- No. of teams per school: 1
- Participants per team: 6 - 8
- Time limit: 3-4 minutes.
- Theme: **Mystery behind masks.**
- Music and backdrop to be submitted through mail ID - spectra@kolasaraswathi.com on or before 15th of July.
- Vulgarity is strictly prohibited.
- Clothing must be decent.

Eye Conic Stories of Enigma

Storyline Build Up

- No. of participants: 1 per school.
- Kick-off line will be given at the venue.
- Participants will be given 3 minutes to decide the plot.
- No discussion or interruptions will be allowed.
- The medium of oratory is only English.
- Any form of vulgarity will lead to direct disqualification.

Background into the World

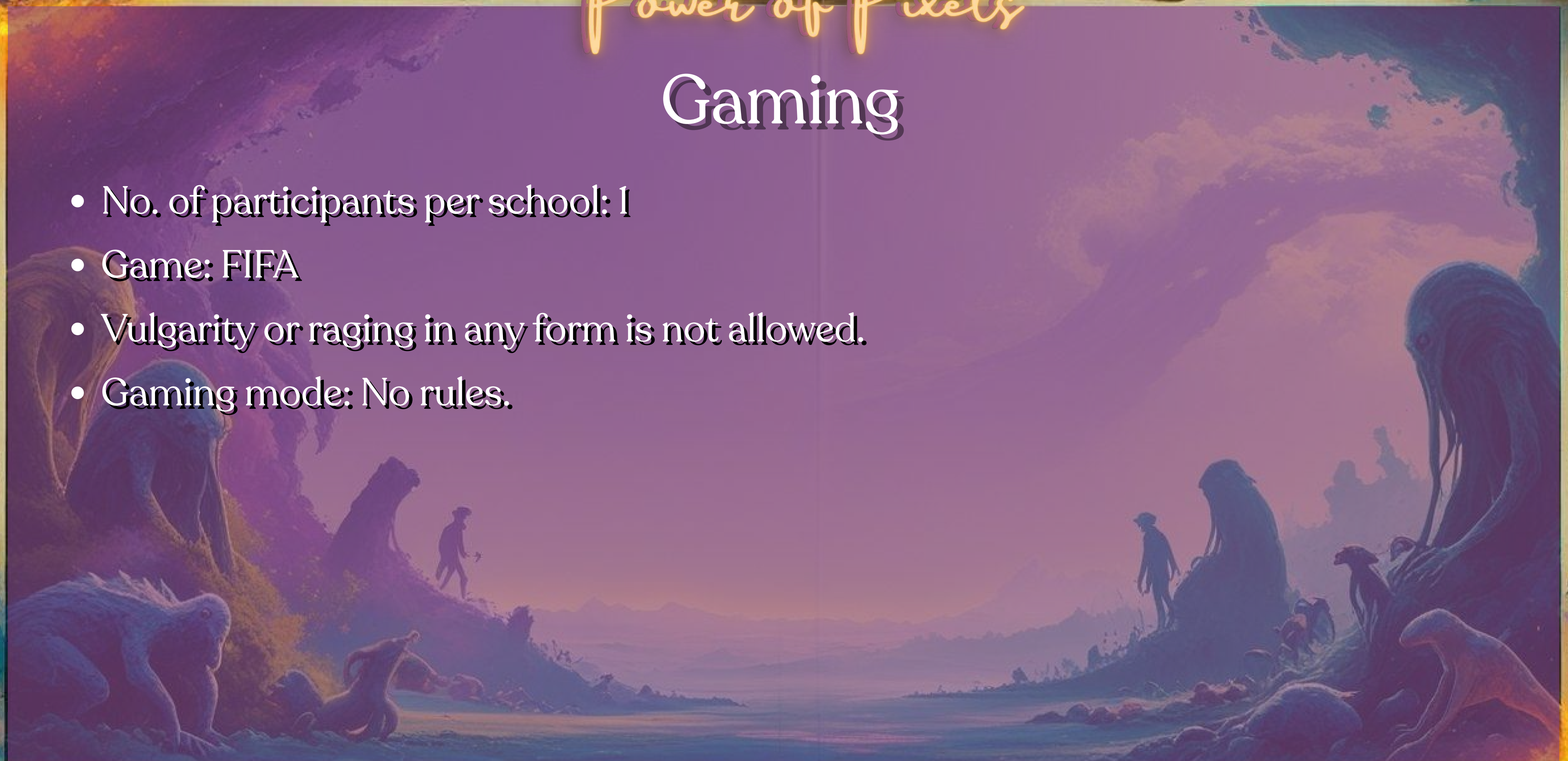
Green Screen

- No. of participants per school: 1
- Participants will be blindfolded and challenged to identify a muted video playing behind them based on clues provided by the judges.
- Evaluation of participants will be based on their reporting skills, creativity, and ability to incorporate humor.
- Vulgarity in any form will not be tolerated.
- Participants violating this will face immediate disqualification.
- Participants are expected to respect and adhere to the judge's instructions.

Power of Pixels

Gaming

- No. of participants per school: 1
- Game: FIFA
- Vulgarity or raging in any form is not allowed.
- Gaming mode: No rules.



Bat the of Bucks

IPL Auction

- A team of 3 students from each school can participate.

Auction Budget:

- Each team will be allotted 2,000,000 points (two million points) for bidding on players.

Team Composition:

- Every team must purchase exactly 12 (11 playing + 1 impact) players during the auction.
- Failure to complete the team with 12 players will result in disqualification.
- Each player will be assigned a performance score between 1 and 10, based on their last year's performance.

Battle of Bunches

IPL Auction

Scoring System

- The team's final score will be calculated as follows:
- Total Performance Score of all 12 players + 10 points for every 10,000 points unused from the budget.
- (Example: 50,000 unused points = $50,000 / 10,000 \times 10 = 50$ bonus points)

Winner Determination

- The team with the highest final score (player performance score + bonus points) will be declared the winner.

General Conduct

- Bidding must be fair and transparent.
- The decision of the event incharge and judges will be final.

Short Video On Spectra

- No. of participants per school: 2
- This is a team event.
- Videos can be shot only inside the campus for both the days.
- Craft and submit a powerful 3-4 minute video that captures the theme with creativity, originality, and impact.
- The final video must be submitted on Day 2 by 2:00 pm via - spectra@kolasaraswathi.com
- All the participants must be present on both the days.
- Internet access will not be provided by the school.
- Gimbals are allowed.

Pour Fest Mess

Resin Art

- No. of teams per school: 1 (Participants - 2)
- Theme: **Nebular Mirage**
- Meaning - Translucent layers resembling deep space clouds - use purples, teals and star burst glitters.
- Duration: 90 Minutes
- Students must bring their own materials.
- Protect the skin from contact with resin, eye protection is also recommended.
- Participants will be judges based on creativity, theme, presentation, work process and cleanliness.
- Reference image is not allowed.

Rep - Apocalypse

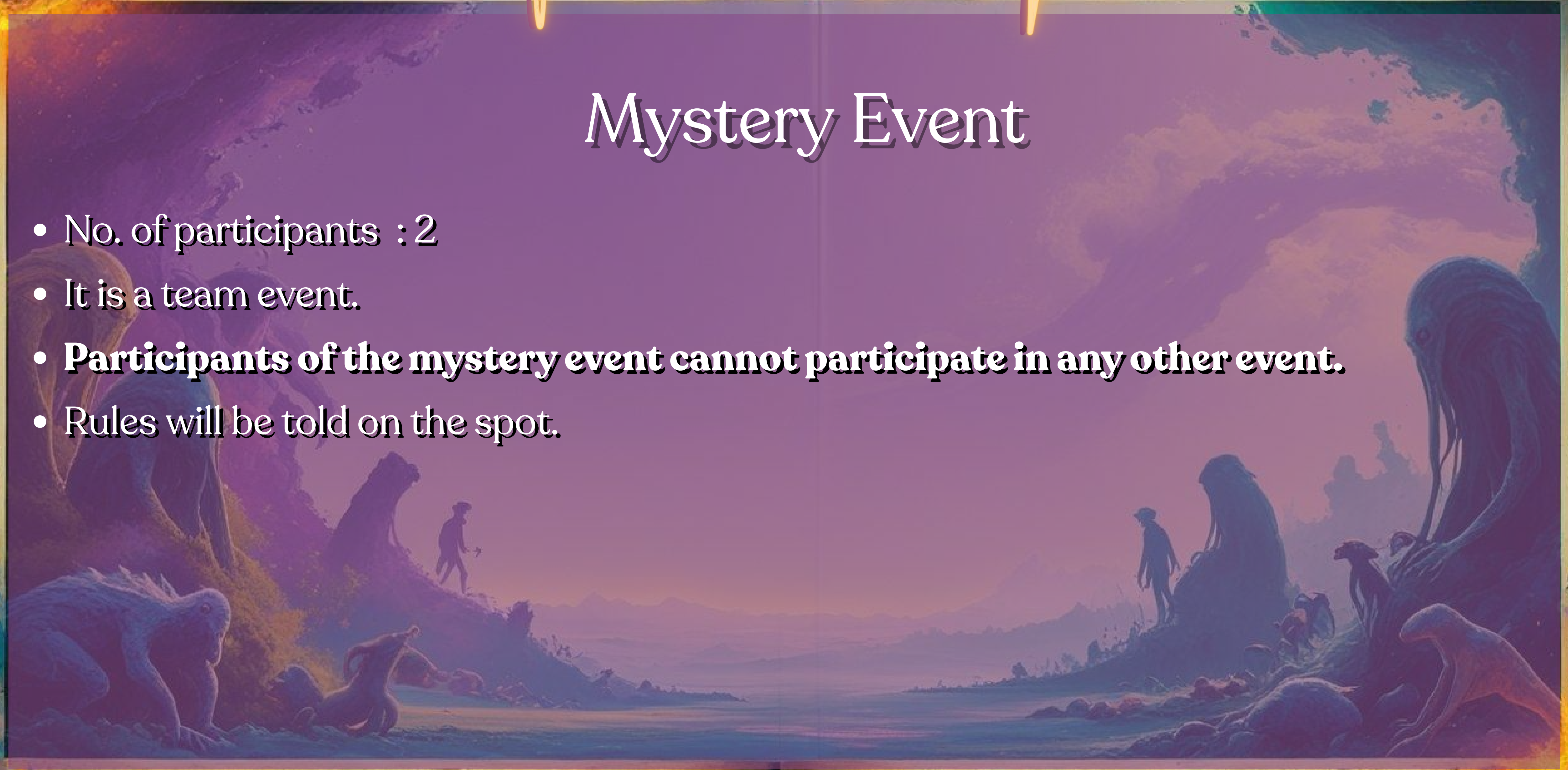
Fitness Clash

- No. of participants: 1
